Category	Age	Timing
SENIOR 12 to 20 skaters	Seniors : all skaters, except for 4 maximum, must have reached the age of 15 by July 1st of the competition year. The 4 skaters “Outside criterion” need to have reached the age of 12 by July 1st of the competition year	Choreographic exercise : 2’30 + free program 5’30 +/- 10 seconds
JUNIOR 12 to 20 skaters	Junior: all skaters, except for 4 maximum, must have reached the age of 11 but not have reached the age of 19 by July 1st of the competition year. The 4 skaters “Outside criterion” may be outside the age range by 3 years maximum (8 years old minimum for the youngest, less than 22 years old for the oldest, by July 1st of the competition year).	Choreographic exercise : 2’30 + free program 5’00 +/- 10 seconds
NOVICE 12 to 20 skaters	Novice: all skaters, except for 4 maximum, must have reached the age of 8 but not have reached the age of 15 by July 1st of the competition year. The 4 skaters “Outside criterion” may be outside the age range by 3 years maximum (5 years old minimum for the youngest, less than 18 years old for the oldest, by July 1st of the competition year).	Choreographic exercise : 2’30 + free program 4’30 +/- 10 seconds
	The same number of skaters must compete in the CE and FS. But 4 Skaters who are on the roster may change from the CE and FS.	No test required

Senior, Junior, Novice : from 12 (minimum) to 20 (maximum) skaters in competition. Novice, Junior and Senior teams may have a roster from 12 to 24 skaters. (maximum number of skaters on the ice for EC and FS is 20).
